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Right-of-Way Permit 1570-00-020, issued November 2, 1999 to WWC Holding Company, Inc., Bellevue, Washington (hereinafter Permittee), is hereby amended to reflect clarification of verbiage and actual infrastructure.

The effect of these changes will be to provide actual descriptions of infrastructure affected by this Right-of-Way Permit.

This Amendment is categorically excluded from NEPA compliance under 516 DM 6, Appendix 7, Section 7.4, Paragraphs C (16) and C (13).

Page 2 MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, paragraph one.

Actual height of Old Faithful antenna tower is amended to read 100-foot antenna tower instead of a 70-foot antenna tower, as authorized by Assistant Superintendent Marv Jensen per the Administrative Record entry dated May 26, 2000.

Page 2 MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, paragraph two.

The third sentence is amended to read "The WTF equipment is located in the existing 16 x 30-foot cell site building (formerly owned by MetaComm, now owned by Union Telephone Company) near the existing Qwest Telecommunication microwave site and the National Park Service (NPS) water tower."

Page 2 MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, paragraph two.

Actual height of Grant Village antenna tower is amended to read 120-foot instead of 80-foot as authorized by Assistant Superintendent Marv Jensen per the Administrative Record entry dated September 27, 1999.

New paragraph to include the Mount Washburn WTF site as per the Consent to Assignment document signed by Assistant Superintendent Marv Jensen, April 28, 2000.

MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, paragraph three.

"WWC purchased and now maintains/operates the former MetaComm WTF located on Mount Washburn. The Mount Washburn site is located west of the sixth principal meridian, County of Park, State of Wyoming. Geographical coordinates: 44 degrees, 47 minutes, 51 seconds, north latitude and 110 degrees, 26 minutes, 02 seconds west, longitude. This equipment is housed in the lower level of the Mount Washburn building owned by the NPS and the associated antenna equipment is attached to the existing guardrail located on the upper deck of the Mount Washburn Observation Tower."

New paragraph to include the Bunsen Peak WTF site as per the Consent to Assignment document signed by Assistant Superintendent Marv Jensen, April 28, 2000.

MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, paragraph four.

"WWC purchased and now maintains/operates the former MetaComm WTF located on Bunsen Peak. The Bunsen Peak site is located west of the sixth principal meridian, County of Park, State of Wyoming. Geographical coordinates: 44 degrees, 55 minutes, 59 seconds, north latitude and 110 degrees, 42 minutes, 26 seconds west, longitude. This WTF consists of cell extender site equipment located in an existing building owned by the Mammoth/Gardiner TVFM Association. Associated antenna equipment is attached to the building and mounted on an existing 30-foot tower owned by the NPS."

Page 5 FEES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS, item 3.

Site fee is now \$500 per site per month rather than \$400. This reflects fair market value adjustment as allowed in said paragraph. The effective date of this change is November 1, 2002.
